On 28-29 March 2011, Department of Economics and Centre for Economic Research at Norwegian University of Science and Technology organize a workshop on 'Educational Systems and Human Capital'. The purpose is to stimulate research in the broad area of economics of education, and to bring together young and experienced researchers. The workshop will put particular emphasis on incentives in educational institutions and the various effects generated thereof, including non-pecuniary effects of education.

The keynote speakers are **Hessel Oosterbeek**, University of Amsterdam, and **Mikael Lindahl**, University of Uppsala.

The **deadline** for submission of papers is 5 January, 2011. Young researchers are particularly encouraged to submit. For submission, please send the paper, or 2-3 page abstract, to kaja.brugard@sof.ntnu.no. Authors of submitted papers will be notified about acceptance by the end of January.

The organizing committee consists of Torberg Falch, Hans Bonesrønning, Lars-Erik Borge, and Bjarne Strøm, all at Department of Economics, Norwegian University of Science and Technology. The organizer will provide accommodation and reimburse economic travel costs for authors presenting a paper.
