On 30-31 May 2016, Department of Economics and Center for Economic Research at Norwegian University of Science and Technology organize a workshop on ‘Education, Skills, and Labor Market Outcomes’ in Trondheim. The purpose is to stimulate research in the broad area of economics of education, and to bring together young and experienced researchers. The workshop will put particular emphasis on incentives shaped by educational systems on adult skills and further labor market outcomes.
